Exclusive Rights

- Reproduction (includes storage)
- Distribution
- Communication
- Translation
- Adaptation
- Sell or Rent
- 2D \leftrightarrow 3D

Other rights

- TPMs – intent to infringe
- RMIs – knowingly distributes / communicates

Those Primarily Implicated

- Reproduction Right
- Communication
- Adaptation

Those Potentially Implicated

- Distribution Right
- Translation
- Sell or Rent
- TPMs & RMIs

What does copyright NOT Protect?

- Ideas – Idea Expression Dichotomy & Merger Doctrine
- Facts, Styles, Patterns, Themes
- De Minimis Use
- Uses that serve a Transformative Purpose (Guidebooks)
- Derivative works that are Transformative Expressions - beyond minimal degree of creativity – not trivial variations / garden variety
- Fair dealing – “*Private or personal use, including research*”
- Transient or Incidental Storage
- TPM circumvention with no intent to infringe

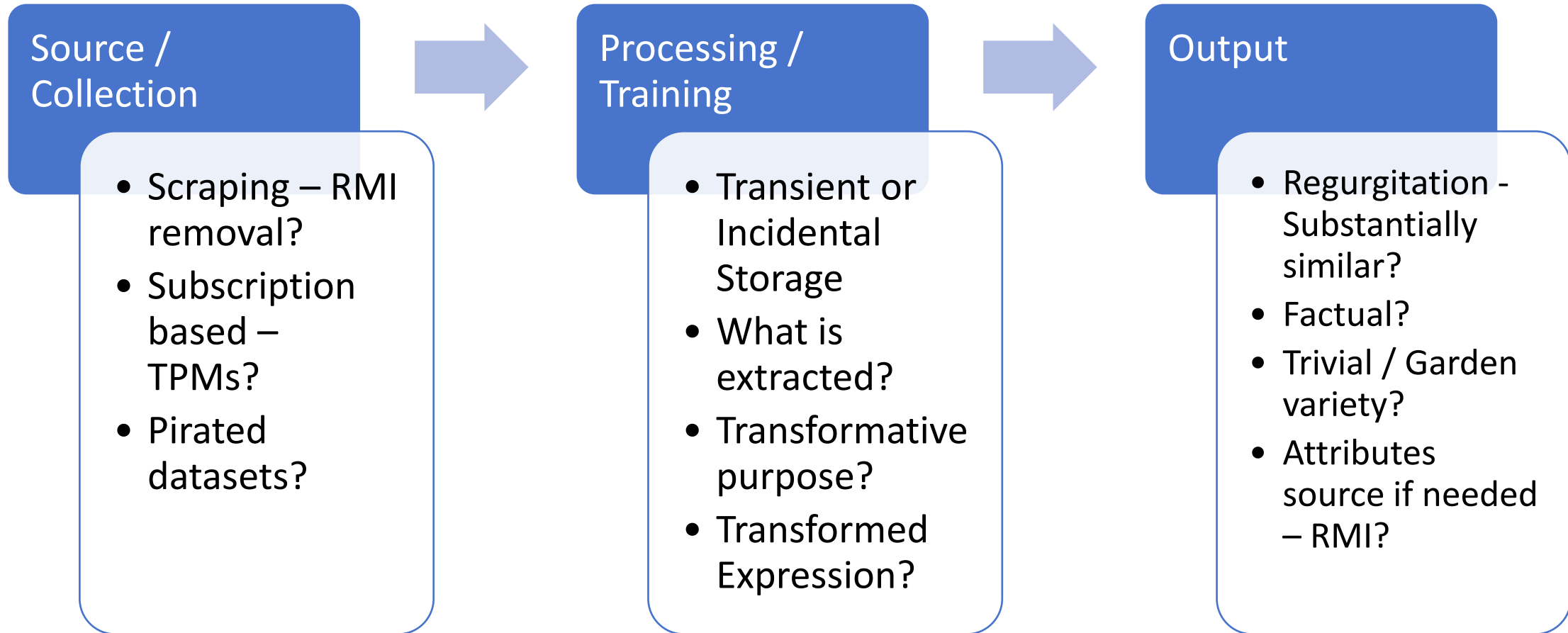

Know your exposure early..

- Is copyright even implicated?
 - To what extent?
 - At what stage?
- Risk / Harms based versus Precautionary approach
